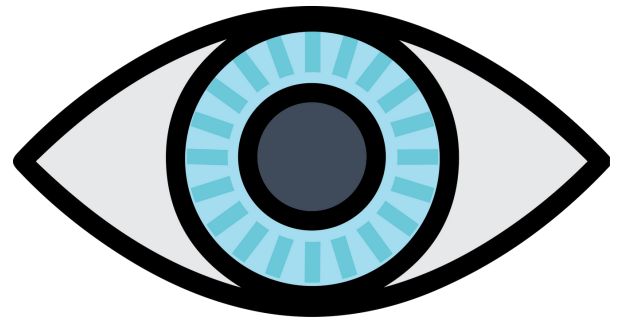

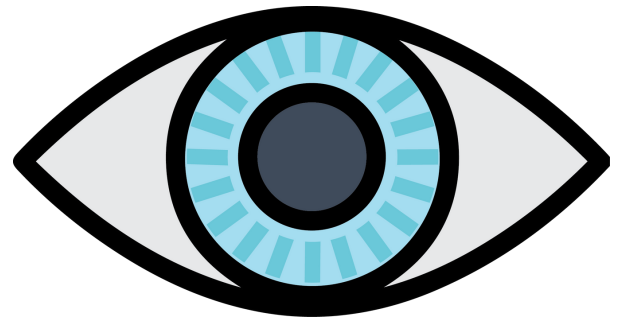

## **New York State Driver License Requirement Categories**

- 1** Unrestricted driver's license: 20/40 or better with or without corrective lenses in at least one eye.

**Low Vision Optometry of Western NY can help with vision in the following two categories:**

- 2** 20/40-20/70 vision in at least one eye with or without correction and a field of at least 140 degrees. May have restrictions such as daytime driving only.
- 3** Telescopic driver license: 20/70-20/100 in at least one eye, 20/40 through a telescopic lens, and at least 140-degree field of view. This license may also have restrictions such as daytime driving only.
